

## Come along on this Mission Trip.

Travelling to Honduras for the mission trip costs approximately \$950 for travel expenses for each person. We are asked to contribute \$200 per person for materials, but our church has consistently been able to provide much more than that amount. Costs for travel and materials are raised through donations, Outreach support and personal contributions.

It costs about \$2000 to build one cement block house. The block is made at the village, mixing the cement by hand on the ground and forming the block in a form press. Foundations are poured and mortar mixed by hand also. The Honduran men receive training in the skills to build the house and work in teams to build the houses in the community. We work with the building teams, depending on each individual's skills. The work can be hard, but there are also tasks that are simple or not physically demanding.

## Cerro Azul, Honduras

Second Presbyterian Church has made a 5 year commitment to the community of Cerro Azul in the rural mountains of Honduras. We will be working with the people of the community to build solid homes of cinder block. These people live with severe poverty, having little employment, health care or secure housing. Their homes now are made of sticks and mud, on land that is not theirs. Through the mission initiative of the Presbyterian Missionaries Tim and Gloria Wheeler, the people have purchased land and are organizing to develop a building plan for their community. When we come to Cerro Azul, we will provide money for building materials and work with them in construction of the homes.
