

## Happy 192nd Birthday!

Second Presbyterian Church was founded on January 12, 1833. We are an off-shoot of First Presbyterian Church, Carlisle, which was founded in 1733.

#### Our Church Building is a Tool for Ministry

The Session has been trying a new system for making the building available to as many internal ministries and outside groups as possible while continuing to prioritize our core mission of making disciples who make a difference. Because of this we have been able to host many community groups and special events. Elder Pat Butler is our Building Use Volunteer who coordinates this ministry of hospitality.

You'll soon see some new carpet in the Rotunda (but it will look exactly the same). We use replaceable carpet squares that can easily be interchanged when stained beyond cleaning.

The Chapel is also getting new carpet! We've finally picked out the color, and we will be able to install it soon after it arrives. This project was funded by a generous gift from the family of Susan and Roberts McCrea.

The window replacement project for the Rotunda wing of the building will soon be fully completed. The 44 windows that were replaced in years past will have nail holes filled and trim and sills will be clear coated and polyurethaned.

The Safety and Security Team has continued to take steps that will benefit all of us. Several trees have been trimmed to lessen the chance of falling debris injuring someone or creating a tripping hazard. AED training is happening. And the Facilities Committee just received a generous grant from the GB Stuart Foundation toward the cost of upgrading the security around our main entrance.

## What is the "Every Member Offering"?



Our congregation is blessed to be part of a large and loving extended Presbyterian family, formally known as the Presbyterian Church (USA). In 2025 Second Church will be assessed \$34.04 for every confirmed member of our congregational family. This cost is based on the local, regional, and national expenses of running a denomination with global reach. The Session attempts to offset this cost (over \$17,000 in 2024) by asking every member to make an offering to cover their "per capita" assessment. ### **Tres Rios Border Foundation Trip**

The mission of the *Tres Rios* Foundation is to inform PC(USA) congregations about immigration issues and processes and connect them to real ministry and ways to help on the border and beyond. We want to understand root causes, understand immigration reform and the push/pull factors of global migration. We are exploring how Second Church in Carlisle, PA (almost 2000 miles away) faithfully respond to the issues of immigration at the border and support this ministry on the border.

## Buckets of Love – A Great Way to Respond to Natural Disasters



Some of you may remember in May of 2018, the Serve Team sponsored an all-church service project called Buckets of Love. The buckets were 5-gallon buckets and members were encouraged to provide all the items needed for disaster clean up. This project, spearheaded by the Serve Team, focused on filling 5-gallon buckets that Presbyterian Disaster Assistance distributes in areas facing natural disasters. The buckets provide cleaning supplies, trash bags, clothes lines, all the things one might need immediately after experiencing a major disaster. The Serve Team had secured the buckets in December 2024. Little did we know that with the devastating fires in California and the flooding in the south our decision would be so timely. There is an extremely specific list of items needed, and the Serve Team is at the very beginning of organizing. You can begin planning right now with a group of friends or family members to sponsor/fill one of the buckets which is valued at \$75. Please pray for all the people who have been affected by both disasters, the

emergency responders and keep your eyes and ears peeled for the list of items needed, deadlines and other ways you can help.

#### Items to be collected for each bucket are:

- Five scouring pads (No stainless steel or pads with soap in them. Remove from packaging.)
- Seven sponges, including one large
- One scrub brush (With or without handle.)
- 18 reusable, lightweight multipurpose cleaning towels (Not paper towels. Remove from packaging.)
- One 16-34 oz. bottle of liquid dish soap (antibacterial preferred)
- One 12-40 oz. bottle of liquid concentrate household cleaner that can be mixed with water (No spray bottles.)
- One 50-100 ft. clothesline (Cotton or plastic line.)
- Five dust masks (N95 particulate respirator dust masks preferred; No surgical masks.)
- Two pairs of heavy-duty, waterproof dishwashing gloves (Latex-free preferred. Durable for multiple-use. Remove from packaging.)
- One pair of heavy-duty, reusable work gloves (Such as Nitrile, cotton with leather palm, or all leather)
- 20-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll (Remove from packaging.)

## Children, Youth, and Families Ministry

#### Our Sunday Morning Children and Youth program now has a new

name! "SecondKids" (for 1st Graders to Fifth Graders) continues to meet weekly from 9:30 to 10:30 in Glory's Edge. Programming for the new year centers around Christian Affirmations for kids on the theme of "Who does God say I am?" Our first lesson of the series is "You are brave!" (Joshua 1:9) We learn the story of David and how brave he was to fight Goliath and how he defeated him with God's help. Following weeks will include: "I am loved," "I am special," "I am strong," "I am forgiven," "I am kind," and "I am a child of God."

Our **Nursery** is up and running and is open Sundays from 9:30 to 11:30am. We have also started a "Preschool Praise" program which happens during the older "Kids Praise" time with Michelle Trefern. Preschoolers (ages 0 to 5) learn age-appropriate worship songs and can do other bible activities in the nursery with Bekah Barlow.

**SHINE!** is designed especially for 6th graders through 12th graders. It prepares these students to shine for Jesus Christ in their schools, family, community, and the church. Pastor Jeff leads this experience on Sundays at 9am.
