




Second Church: Working Together with our Mission Partners

Project Share is currently experiencing some changes in personnel. With the departure of the recently hired CEO to replace long standing CEO Bob Weed, they have selected two members of their team to serve in Interim positions: Emma Witwer-Interim CEO & Nutrition Coordinator and Asani Mukusa-Interim CEO and Warehouse Coordinator. Join the Serve Team in praying for the staff and Board of Directors of Project Share as they evaluate their next steps.

Sunday, September 17 was the annual Fare for Share for **Project Share**. Unfortunately, Carlisle received a much-needed day of rain, which proved to be a challenge for this event, and they did not reach their fundraising goals. The Farmstand is now offering Your Choice shopping for any Cumberland County resident, there are no qualifying requirements. Your Choice shopping allows the clients to select only those items their family will eat. By Appointment Only.

The Serve Team will be collecting items for "Welcome Home Kits" for **Community CARES** clients who are transitioning from experiencing homelessness into an apartment or home. Watch for a specific list and more information in the coming weeks.

The Seeds class (new members) will be preparing and serving dinner (4-5pm) on Monday, October 16, at **Community CARES**, but they need our help. Safe Harbour Building Update: Safe Harbour is building and renovating 43 new housing units. Construction on 40 units has begun and will be completed by next fall. This construction is happening on Spring Garden Street in Carlisle near the Carlisle United Methodist Church. Three units are also being renovated on High Street near the First Lutheran Church. This begins the process of adding more units to the growing need for low-income housing. Scott Shewell President and CEO tells us that right now, in Carlisle, there is a need for over 300 units.

His Hands Auto Repair Ministry, Inc. and Auto Sales are getting a new roof on their facility. Some materials and labor have been donated and the Serve Team has agreed to help with the cost of insulation. We'll keep you posted on this project. In the meantime, did you know that anyone can use the services of His Hands Auto Repair? They provide professional service; you can donate a used vehicle and you can even buy a vehicle. Their goal is to assist the financially challenged within our community, while offering affordable auto repairs to the public.



The Breakfast Table

Sunday mornings at 9 am Second Church serving on Sunday, October 29th beginning at 8:30 am.

New Life Community began the Breakfast table in 2005, while we were still at the Carlisle Theater. We began noticing that people were hungry because of the gap in the community meals over the weekends. And so we began serving a free breakfast every Sunday morning.

The Breakfast Table is a free meal that is open to anyone and everyone in the community. There is a natural draw for individuals that are experiencing homelessness, however, we provide an open invitation to people who are from all walks of life. This is a place where we build community. We believe in the power of the story and that everyone has a story to tell. What better place for this to happen than at the Table. Second Church began partnering with New Life Community in 2021. On the fifth Sundays Second Church provides the food and serves the meal. This is an opportunity to interact with members from New Life Community as well as individuals needing a meal on Sunday mornings. If you are looking for an opportunity to meet people in need, serve the community and hear their stories, this is the place for you. Our next opportunity to provide the food and serve the meal will be Sunday, October 29th at 8:30 am.

In 2006 Second Church bought the home next to our Rockledge Drive entrance. Since then it has been used for many purposes and has been occupied by several tenants, including missionaries from overseas, visiting pastors serving other congregations, and ordinary folks. It has also been vacant for many months at a time. The Session's Mission House Task Force has been working for months to prepare to make a recommendation regarding the future of the house. Options under consideration include everything from an outright sale to a lease-type arrangement with a mission partner that might be able to use it for ministry purposes.
